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PROJECT DETAILS

Overview

SALTA Properties, owner of a 40-hectare industrial estate in Altona in Melbourne's west, leased five hectares to international shipping giant MAERSK LINE.

The site saw the development of an intermodal freight terminal, housing a 20,000 litre container wash bay facility, a 2,500m² container repair workshop, a 1,500 square metre container repair workshop and a 1,500m² container survey area.

Alex Fraser contributions

In addition to the above, a sealed yard of 43,000m² was planned. Alex Fraser prepared the area, primed the CTCR base and applied two 50mm layers of Polymer Modified Asphalt.

Alex Fraser supplied the materials and paved the large site within the set timeframe and according to strict specifications. Some sections of the area required over 20 4.5m wide paver runs to minimise the number of construction joints.

Without impacting on the supply of other Alex Fraser Asphalt projects, over 1,400 tonnes were supplied and over 11,000m² paved in a single shift.
